


## Online Simulation Programmes

As a part of preparing the Asian partners for accreditation, University of Bremen and University of Evora conducted a series of online simulation programmes from March 2022 to June 2022.

Throughout this series, 3 Asian partners, namely; Maldives National University, Riphah International University, Pakistan and University of Peradeniya were able to revisit the degree programmes of Bachelor of Business, Bachelor of Science in Computer Science and Bachelor of Science in Engineering honours in Manufacturing and Industrial Engineering that they seek to accredit and their readiness.

Experts from University of Bremen including Prof. Dr. Hans Dietrich Haasis, Prof. Dr. Klaus Dieter Thoben and Svenja Schell and experts from University of Evora Vitor Nogueira, André Rato, Eduardo Medeiros and Artur Romão shared their insights to further develop the processes and documentation related to accreditation.





## **ON-SITE TRAINING IN BREMEN**

The first on-site physical training programme under the SSAPI project was held in Bremen, Germany, from 04-15 July 2022, hosted by the University of Bremen. A total of 56 participants representing the 2 European and 9 Asian partner universities participated in this 2-week training programme.



The training programme included a variety of activities designed to share knowledge and experience across the higher education institutions (HEIs) on programme development and accreditation. Activities included simulation of programme accreditation in engineering, psychology, electrical engineering, business administration and computer science, as developed by partner universities.

Tours of facilities at the University of Bremen, including the LogDynamics Lab, BIBA and the State and University Library Bremen (SUB), were also included as part of sharing institutional experience among the partners. Opportunities were also given to participants to attend classes and observe examples of project-based learning at the university.
